Greetings and thanks to all of you who pray for us and this ministry. We would like to report that God answered many of your prayers this past winter. He went before us in planned travel to South Carolina, Guatemala and Japan. May we share some of the details with you? I hope this will encourage each of you.



CIU Mission's Week

OCT. 2024

October in South Carolina. Chris joined Mike Branch at the Columbia International University (CIU) mission's week in South Carolina. It was a special time to talk with students and recruit some of them for

short-term mission trips in the future. Chris had the privilege of meeting and doing an interview with Dr. Ed Smither, the Dean of the mission department at the university. It was wonderful to spend time with Mike and Terri Branch who are now representing the mission in Columbia. Pray for the seven students at Columbia International University who expressed interest in short-term mission trips in the future. Pray also about the possibility of the mission opening a satellite office near Columbia International University.



November in Guatemala. The Fraternity for the Advancement of Missions (FAM) agencies across Central America met in Guatemala for

their triennial meeting. They invited Chris to attend and represent Liebenzell USA along with Rod Fry and Fernando Amezcua of Mexico. During his time there Chris enjoyed fellowship with people from Guatemala, Panama, Honduras, Costa Rica, and Mexico. These Central American brothers promote missionary interests throughout their churches, denominations, and contacts. Chris led devotionals each day from the book of Colossians. Several of the participants commented to him how much the daily time in God's word meant to them.

During those meetings, three countries showed interest in partnering with Liebenzell USA to promote dual membership. This is an interesting concept in that a Central American missionary can raise prayer and financial support in their home country, and with potential supporters living in the United States, to help complete 100% of their support to go to the mission field. **Pray for FAM Panama and FAM Honduras representatives who are currently meeting with their agencies to finalize an agreement.** Give thanks that we now have an agreement with FAM Costa Rica.



December in Japan. By invitation, Chris traveled and joined with Brad Greenstreet, Liebenzell USA co-di-

rector for Asia. They visited with the Liebenzell Germany missionaries in Japan, including field leader Andreas Gross (photo to right), traveled across the island, and met with local Japanese church leaders. They saw a conference center and several local church buildings. They discovered new ministry opportunities in urban and rural settings across the country.






January in Spain and North Africa. The staff and professors at the Sevilla Theological Seminary work hard throughout the year and look forward to

an annual retreat. Chris was able to join them in the mountains of Sevilla and enjoyed a time of fellowship studying Psalm 37:1-5. He also took several days to explore a country in North Africa, where he was able to teach a class on evangelism on the Internet. Please pray for open opportunities in North Africa as well as the teaching ministry that Chris and Beth have around the Spanish-speaking world through the Sevilla Theological Seminary.

February in Caribbean. Two men from North Carolina went with Chris down to the Caribbean for a week of ministry in a town west of

the capital. For many years the Sevilla theological seminary ministry has been training close to 200 students across the island for future ministry opportunities as teachers, evangelists, and church planters. Chris and friends were able to visit one of the classes and also evangelize in a town of 3,000 people. They also shared the gospel with 115 different individuals in homes, stores, vehicles, and provided pocket gospels of John. A total of 90 individuals prayed to receive Christ in their hearts as their Savior!

We were able to take in generous donations of personal hygiene items including combs, shampoo, toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, antacids, and related items. The Caribbean people were so happy to also receive 46 baseball gloves, enough to outfit four teams for sports evangelism. Finally, through special donations we were able to see the churches acquire additional land to expand and enlarge their sanctuary


